May 16, Romani Resistance Day, is an important commemoration of the resistance and also the suffering of Romani people during the period of the Porajmos, Nazi regime's rule in Europe. Regretfully, the significance or even the existence of this day and the events it recalls and commemorates are not widely known or recognized.

"From my perspective, of course we can not understand the concentration camp situation exactly. But, we can get an insight from this experience and we can understand it by looking at our own lives and our resistance: we are organic creatures and actually we have a lot of possibilities in our body and in our life. As we know or feel, human beings cannot exactly fit in any category or into what society expects, it is our resistance."
