ABSTRACT | In 2022, about one million Russian citizens left the country after the Kremlin initiated the full-scale invasion of Ukraine, declared military mobilization, and intensified internal repressions to prohibit any public anti-war demonstrations. In exile, many migrants started forming anti-war initiatives aiming to provide legal support to political prisoners, assist Ukrainian refugees, spread anti-war rhetoric and fight Russia's propaganda. The roundtable "*Voices of the Russian diaspora: Media and Opposition to the Kremlin War*" brings together Russian scholars and activists to discuss the difficult questions related to collective responsibility of the Russian citizens, the political participation and challenges of the newly formed exiled communities, and the role of media in fostering opposition to the Kremlin's war.
