Often compared with the classic film “Breakfast Club,” Filipović’s film had earned, among others, the Young Audience Award at the Sarajevo Film Festival in 2015. In the reviews, the film has been described as “engaging, funny, humane teen drama.” We happily invite you to attend this screening and to discuss the film with the director, as well as the important issues that the film addresses, such as education, history and revisionism of World War II history in Serbia, sexuality and many others.
